- Time / URL links / Content text colours / period for each banner is set in administration panel
- Transition Easing Duration time is set in administration panel
- Enable - disable / Auto play / Menu
- Easy to use
- Help files are easy to understand and follow.

**Module Class Suffix** - A suffix to be applied to the css class of the module (table.moduletable), this allows individual module styling

**SWFObject script** - Mode 1 will use a local copy. Mode 2 will use the file hosted by Google. Safe mode will switch to a safe embedding code

**Global Width** - Set up the global stage width, the actual width of the flash animation

**Global Height** - Set up the global stage height, the actual height of the flash animation

**Transition Style** – There are three transition styles. 1. Fade IN-OUT creates a simple fade between pictures. 2. Right to left, makes the images slide one on top of the other from right side of the module to the left side. 3. Bottom to top, makes the images slide one on top of the other from bottom side of the module to the top.

**Transition Time** – Determines the time of the transition, from the loading start point to fully show the image. (We recommend that you set up a maximum 3 seconds transition time)

**Menu Visible** – Choose if you want to show or hide the navigation bar (numbers)

**Menu Width** – Set the width of the navigation bar

**Menu Height** – Set the height of the navigation bar

**Menu Left Space** - Set the left space of the navigation bar (0 - starts from the left, no spaces)

**Menu Bottom Space** - Set the bottom space of the navigation bar (0 - starts from the bottom, no spaces)

**Menu Background Colour** – Use colour picker to choose the navigation bar background colour





**Menu Number Colour** - Use colour picker to change the number colour when is not selected

**Menu Selected Number Colour** - Use colour picker to change the number colour when selected

**Menu Background Alpha** – Set up the navigation bar background transparency (0% – full transparent, 100% - no transparency)

**Number Box Loading Colour** - Use colour picker to choose the number box loading colour

**Number Box Background Colour** - Use colour picker to choose the number box background colour

**Play/Pause Visibility** – Choose if you want to show or hide the play/pause button

**Play/Pause Right Space** - Set the right space of the play/pause button (0 - starts from the right, no spaces)

**Play/Pause Bottom Space** - Set the bottom space of the play/pause button (0 - starts from the bottom, no spaces)

**Play/Pause Background Colour** - Use colour picker to choose the play/pause button background colour

**Play/Pause Background Alpha** - Set up the play/pause button background transparency (0% – full transparent, 100% - no transparency)

**Play/Pause Icon Colour** - Use colour picker to change the icon colour of the play/pause button

**Auto Start Slideshow** - Choose if you want to automatically start slideshow

**Title Text Width** – Set up the first (title) text width (for best results use the global width)

**Title Font Size** – Set up the font size for the text 1 (title)

**Content 1 Width** – Set up the first content text width (for best results use the global width)

**Content 2 Width** – Set up the second content text width (for best results use the global width)






**Content Font Size** – Set up the font size for the text 2 and 3 (content)

**Content Text Colour** – Use colour picker to change colours for the text 2 and 3 (content)

**Text Top Space** – Set up the space from top to text (0 - starts from the top, no spaces)

**Text Left Space** – Set up the space from left to text (0 - starts from the left, no spaces)

**Show Image** – Choose if you want to enable or disable one slide

**Seconds to show image** – Set up the time to display the image

**Image Path** – Set up the image path (be careful not to use double extensions like “image.jpg.jpg”, always check the path to be correct e.g. “/images/stories/your folder/yourpicture.jpg” without quotes)

**Title Text** – Set up the text for the title position

**Title Text Colour** – Use colorpicker to set up the colour of the title text

**Content 1 Text** - Set up the text for the content 1 position

**Content 1 Background Colour** - Use colorpicker to set up the colour of the content 1 text

**Content 1 Background Alpha** - Set up the content 1 background transparency (0% – full transparent, 100% - no transparency)

**Content 2 Text** - Set up the text for the content 1 position

**Content 2 Background Colour** - Use colorpicker to set up the colour of the content 2 text

**Content 2 Background Alpha** - Set up the content 2 background transparency (0% – full transparent, 100% - no transparency)

**Image URL** – Set the URL for the image e.g. <http://www.magicpoint.org>
